

Professor Jerzy Nawrocki MD, PhD. received his medical degree from the Medical University of Lodz in 1980. He received his Professor of Medical Science Degree from the President of Poland in 1999.

In 1990–1991 as an Alexander von Humboldt Foundation scholarship holder he gained professional experience at Department of Ophthalmology at Munich University.

He has been a frequent visitor to the leading European and American Ophthalmologic Departments.

Professor Nawrocki is a founding member and current President of the European Vitreoretinal Society. He is also a member of the following organizations American Academy of Ophthalmology, American Society of Retina Specialists, European Society of Cataract and Refractive Surgeons, German Ophthalmological Society, Polish Ophthalmological Society, Retinologische Gesellschaft, Deutschsprachige Gesellschaft für Intraokularlinsen Implantation und Refraktive Chirurgie, and Societas Humboldtiana Polonorum.

He is involved in anterior and posterior segment of the eye diagnosis and treatment, and is ward head of "Jasne Blonia" Eye Clinic, Lodz, Poland and at the K. Jonscher Hospital, Lodz, Poland. He was the Regional Consultant Ophthalmologist for the Polish region 'Lodzkie' from 2002 to 2012.

He has written more than 100 scientific papers. He presents lectures and videos throughout the world at numerous meetings and conferences. His films have won over 20 international awards and he is the holder of two Honor Awards and Senior Honor Award from the ASRS. And has organized several vitreoretinal symposia and training courses in Poland.
