

## **Brief C V of Dr Mangat R Dogra, PGIMER, Chandigarh, India**

Dr Mangat R Dogra is Professor of Ophthalmology at Advanced Eye Centre, Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education & Research (PGIMER) Chandigarh, India. He obtained MBBS degree from Medical College Shimla in 1977 and MS Ophthalmology at PGIMER Chandigarh, India in 1981. He did vitreo-retinal fellowship from July 1989 to June 1991 at University of Maryland Hospital, Baltimore, USA.

His exclusive area of patient care, teaching and research has been vitreo-retinal diseases and surgery including retinopathy of prematurity (ROP) for the last 27 years. Dr Dogra has published 132 papers in peer-reviewed National and International journals, four books and several book chapters on vitreo-retinal diseases and ROP. He has delivered 512 lectures at various National and International Meetings. He has been invited to deliver 144 guest lectures on ROP in India and abroad.

Dr. Dogra is a former president of Vitreo Retina Society of India.
